We are hoping to launch Windmill as a BMO (separate church community licensed by the Anglican Bishop of Leicester) in early 2019. Lots of work is going on in the background to make this happen. We would like to invite everyone to a meeting on Wednesday 26th September at 7.30pm at Bottesford Methodist Chapel when Jonathan Dowman from Leicester diocese will be coming to explain more about the BMO process and how it fits with where we are and where we are going. We'd really encourage you all to come along to this meeting to share ideas and the vision for Windmill's future.

Children's work update...

The children's team are super excited to announce the launch of two new groups:

Encounter is for children 3-9 (younger children are welcome with a carer) and will be co-ordinated by June Leeke and supported by Wes Marsh. June and Wes will be using the Godly play resources with craft and play to allow the children time and space to understand how the Bible stories relate to them today.

Wonder is our group for 10-14 years olds and we will be using the youth alpha resources to create a space where they can safely ask the BIG questions of life in a non-judgemental environment where every opinion counts. Please invite any 10-14s you know...we'll make them very welcome. The Wonder group will also be going on an away day later this term.

Small Group...starts again on Thursday 6th September and runs weekly through the autumn term on Thursday evenings 7.30-9pm. Those attending have found it a wonderful resource to explore faith and life together. This term, Nina will be leading studies on Bible characters after beginning with a session on the song 'Stir a Passion in my heart, Lord.' Everyone is welcome and you do not need any knowledge of the Bible to come along.
